# **Medicinal Ingredient**

Clofedanol hydrochloride (antitussive), 25 mg/teaspoon (5 mL)

## **Dosing**

**Children 2-6 years:** One-half teaspoonful 3 or 4 times daily as required.

**Children 6-12 years:** One-half to one teaspoonful 3 or 4 times daily as required.

**Adults:** One teaspoonful 3 or 4 times daily as required.

#### **Recommended Use**

For symptomatic relief of cough.

# **Contraindications/Warnings**

- Keep out of reach of children
- Do not use in children under 2 years of age
- Ask your doctor/pharmacist before taking if you are pregnant, breastfeeding or taking other medications or if you have: a persistent cough (such as occurs with smoking), asthma, emphysema; cough with excessive phlegm/mucus; difficulty breathing or other chronic lung conditions
- Stop use and ask a doctor if: symptoms worsen or last for more than 7 days; a fever, rash or persistent headache develops
- In case of overdose, call a Poison Control Centre or doctor right away.
- Do not use if outer safety seal is missing or damaged
